<input type="checkbox"/> Unexplained hotel keys/key cards	<input type="checkbox"/> Child discloses or someone reports that child offered to have sex for money or other payment and then ran before the sex took place.
<input type="checkbox"/> Being groomed and/or sexualized in the Internet	<input type="checkbox"/> Contact with strangers on the Internet and/or sexual risk taking on social medial, such as Facebook, Oovoo, Snapchat, Facebook, Kik, twitter, backpage etc.

<input type="checkbox"/> Known history of prior sexual abuse or sexual acting out	<input type="checkbox"/> Having an older boyfriend or girlfriend, particularly if that person appears controlling or youth appears fearful
